#### **Proposed Changes To The Victorian Club Permit Scheme (VCPS)**

On Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> May, the Association of Motoring Clubs (AOMC) conducted a seminar for member clubs that advised them of forthcoming changes to the VCPS. Vice President, Rod Amos (*Vintage Sports Car Club*) addressed those present about proposed changes to the Scheme.

On arriving at exactly 9:00 am, I got a distinct impression that I had arrived awfully late for the Seminar. There were that many milling around waiting for the East Malvern RSL's doors to open. This was a 'booked only' event, too! Signing in took quite a while when it transpired that a number of non-member clubs were represented as well. Finally the room was filled and proceedings commenced. I will not go into any details here, because VicRoads are sending a letter to all clubs currently operating the VCPS.

The main topic related, almost entirely, to the proposal to allow modified vehicles, other than Street Rods, into the Scheme. There was mention that an 'M' prefixed permit plate could be introduced.

Once our club receives the official letter and information from VicRoads, details will be published in *Your ABCCC News*. Watch out for it, so that you can be kept fully informed.
