This DB6 was purchased by a London syndicate direct from the plant in Newport Pagnell & shipped to Malasia. The designated owner was believed to be the Sultan of Johore Baharu. The car was imported from Singapore in 1981 & purchased by Ross & Pat in 1982. The mileage at that time was 28,528 & it has travelled approx. 15,000 miles over the past 16 years. It is in absolute original condition except for a bare metal repaint in 1982. The value of Aston Martins declined in the late 80's but is now significantly improving.
